What is the Botley Music Festival?

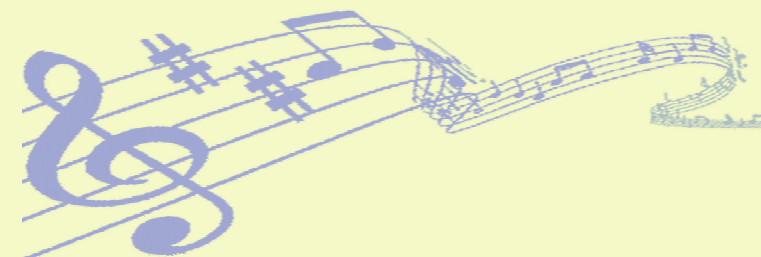
